Please note the dates of the elections scheduled this year:

Nov. 2, 2004	General Election	October 26, 2004	October 18, 2004

If there are people living in your facility who wish to vote by absentee ballot or who need to register to vote, your staff may help by providing them with the necessary forms.

If a person wishes to register to vote for any election, they must complete an Affidavit of registration and return it to our office, by the close of registration **15 days prior to the election**. If you need 50 or fewer registration cards, they can be mailed to you upon request. If you need more than 50 registration cards, someone from your facility must come to our office and complete a distribution form to obtain the cards.

Some persons under conservatorship are not eligible to vote. If you have questions, please check their papers hi regards to their voting rights before registering them to vote.

In order to vote by absentee ballot, a registered voter must send a signed request to this department.

The new law states that anyone can now apply for Permanent Absentee status. These applications are available form the Absentee Voting Section.
