The Independent Living Resource Center, San Francisco (ILRCSF) is a non-profit community organization serving San Francisco's disability population. ILRCSF's mission is to ensure that people with disabilities are full social and economic partners, both within their families and in a fully accessible community. Founded in 1977, our services are delivered in American Sign Language, Cantonese, Mandarin, Spanish and English.

ILRCSF has a multi-layered Systems Change program that places an emphasis on advocating for legislative action which acknowledges and addresses the rights of people with disabilities. As an organization that operates within the Independent Living philosophy – that people with disabilities are the best experts on their needs, and therefore they must take the initiative, individually and collectively, in designing and promoting better solutions – ILRCSF believes the disability movement belongs in the hands of people with disabilities.
