3 monitoring reports. Dkt. 128.


4 Consistent with that order, the parties now submit the Court Experts' final

8 The parties have agreed to meet and confer on the findings and
9 recommendations set forth in the Court Expert reports within fourteen (14) days of
10 this filing, in order to discuss Defendant's response and plans for remedial action, as
11 warranted. Defendant will file, no later than December 8, 2020, a status report that
12 describes its response and any planned remedial action, including new or revised
13 policies, procedures, or directives.

14 Plaintiffs do not seek any further orders at this time. Plaintiffs reserve the right
15 to move for specific enforcement or other relief in light of the forthcoming meet and
16 confer and Defendant's status report.
