## RE: AB 1136 (EGGMAN) as amended July 2, 2018 – SUPPORT [Revised Letter]

Dear Senator Portantino:

Disability Rights California (DRC), a non-profit advocacy organization that advances and protects the rights of Californians with disabilities, **supports AB 1136**. This bill is scheduled for hearing before the Senate Appropriations Committee on August 6, 2018.

AB 1136 Requires the Department of Public Health (DPH) to develop and submit a proposal to solicit a 21<sup>st</sup> Century Cures Act federal grant to develop a real-time, internet-based database to help identify and designate facilities with available beds for the treatment of individuals experiencing a mental health or substance use disorder crisis. A Web-based bed registry would improve mental health service access by getting patients who are dealing with mental health crises to the appropriate professionals more quickly, and streamlining communication to reduce patient waiting time. The inclusion of other community mental health and SUD treatment providers will also help psychiatric facilities find appropriate placements when patients are ready for a lower level of care. This bill demonstrates California's dedication to improving access to mental health services while leveraging federal dollars to maximize the benefit to the state.
