## RE: AB 1436 (LEVINE) as amended June 20, 2018 – SUPPORT

Dear Senator Portantino:

Disability Rights California (DRC), a non-profit advocacy organization that advances and protects the rights of Californians with disabilities, **supports AB 1436.** This bill is scheduled for hearing in the Senate Appropriations Committee on August 6, 2018.

Last year the Governor signed AB 89 (Levine) which requires all applicants for licensure as a psychologist with the Board of Psychology to complete a minimum of six hours of coursework or applied experience in suicide risk assessment and intervention. This follow-up bill would require that all mental health professionals receive suicide prevention training. There has been an increase over the last decade in suicide rates. This bill will improve the competencies of mental health professionals and serve to hopefully contribute toward stemming that tide. AB 1436 (LEVINE) as amended June 20, 2018 – SUPPORT Page 2 of 2
