## RE: AB 2043 (ARAMBULA) as amended June 28, 2018– SUPPORT

Dear Senator Portantino:

Disability Rights California (DRC), a non-profit advocacy organization that advances and protects the rights of Californians with disabilities, **supports AB 2043.** This bill is scheduled for hearing in the Senate Appropriations Committee on August 6, 2018.

Children and caregivers in the child welfare system may be experiencing both short and long-term disabilities that may manifest in times of crises. During those times, supportive assistance can be very important to youth and caregivers to resolve conflicts, de-escalate, or even direct them toward resources. This support helps maintain a supportive relationship between the youth and caregiver.

The approach in this bill provides that support by establishing a statewide, toll-free hotline available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, for caregivers and youth who are experiencing emotional, behavioral or other difficulties and need immediate help by requiring counties to establish mobile response teams to provide face-to-face, in-home response. This is an important tool for supporting youth and caregivers.
