RE: AB 2043 (ARAMBULA) as amended May 25, 2018-SUPPORT

Dear Senator Wiener:

Disability Rights California (DRC), a non-profit advocacy organization that advances and protects the rights of Californians with disabilities, **supports AB 2043.** This bill is scheduled for hearing in the Senate Human Services Committee on June 26, 2018.

Children and caregivers in the child welfare system may be experiencing both short and long-term disabilities that may manifest in times of crises. During those times, supportive assistance can be very important to youth and caregivers to resolve conflicts, de-escalate or even direct them toward resources. This support helps maintain a supportive relationship between the youth and caregiver.

The approach in this bill provides that support by establishing a statewide, toll-free hotline available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, for caregivers and youth who are experiencing emotional, behavioral or other difficulties and need immediate help by requiring counties to establish mobile response teams to provide face-to-face, in-home response. This is an important tool for supporting youth and caregivers.
