SIGNATURE**

Dear Governor Brown:

Disability Rights California (DRC), a non-profit advocacy organization that advances and protects the rights of Californians with disabilities, **supports AB 2219 and requests your signature.**

This bill establishes a simple but common sense requirement that landlords accept rent payments from third parties, such as non-profit or government agencies, and protects landlords by requiring, along with the payment, a written acknowledgment that the payment does not create a landlord-tenant relationship. During this time of extreme housing shortages, every possible strategy for preventing homelessness should be employed. AB 2219 is one of those strategies for preventing homelessness.
