RE: AB 2448 (GIPSON) as introduced – SUPPORT

Dear Senator Portantino:

Disability Rights California (DRC), a non-profit advocacy organization that advances and protects the rights of Californians with disabilities, **supports AB 2448.** This bill is scheduled for hearing in the Senate Appropriations Committee on August 6, 2018.

Foster youth in out-of-home placements and juveniles in local detention facilities may be cut off from Internet access for extended periods of time. AB 2448 would ensure youth in foster care and youth in juvenile detention facilities have access to computer technology and the Internet, which is crucial for these youth to have communication with their family and access to online school information or other educational materials. Technology is an essential component of modern communication and individuals without it are at a severe disadvantage.

We must give our most disadvantaged youth an opportunity to thrive in their communities. Providing Internet access to youth in foster care and in juvenile detention facilities is an important step in ensuring that they have access to a broader scope of information that technology provides.
