**RE: AB 2749 (BONTA) as amended August 21, 2018 – REQUEST FOR
SIGNATURE**

Dear Governor Brown:


Disability Rights California (DRC), a non-profit advocacy organization that advances and protects the rights of Californians with disabilities, **supports AB 2749 and requests your signature.**

AB 2749 requires the director of each state agency or state entity and each chief information officer to post on its' home page a certification that its Internet Web site is mobile-friendly. The bill would also prohibit an Internet Web site maintained by a state agency that is intended for use by the public from becoming operational unless it is mobile friendly and accessible by persons with disabilities.

The primary point for the public to access information and apply for benefits has shifted to on-line sources. This bill continues the move toward ensuring that state agencies and entities have internet systems that are broadly accessible to the public and persons with disabilities.

For these reasons, DRC supports this bill and requests your signature. Please contact me if you have any questions about our position or if I can provide any further information.
