Do you know your rights?

- As a resident of a board and care home in California these are some of your rights:
- To dignity, privacy and humane care.
- The right to transportation to medical and dental services.
- 24 hour supervision.
- To keep and spend a reasonable sum of your own money.
- Freedom from discrimination.
- A right to have safe, healthful and comfortable conditions.
- A right to leave or return to the facility at any time and not be locked into or out of the building, day or night.
- A right to have visitors.
- A right to move from a facility in accordance with the terms of the admission agreement.
