## RE: SB 1021 (WIENER) as amended June 14, 2018 – SUPPORT

Dear Assembly Member Gonzalez Fletcher:

Disability Rights California (DRC), a non-profit advocacy organization that advances and protects the rights of Californians with disabilities, **supports SB 1021.** This bill will soon come before you for hearing in the Assembly Appropriations Committee.

SB 1021 takes a common-sense approach to helping consumers who need expensive prescription drugs by revising the way prescription drug benefits are applied when the retail price of a drug is less than the drug plan's applicable copayment. Consumers should not be caught in the middle of negotiations between health plans, drug plans, pharmacy benefit managers – in short any entity in the distribution line for a prescription drug – when the simplest approach saves money. If the retail price is lower than the copay, the retail price becomes the copay.
