Dear Senator Lara:

Disability Rights California (DRC), a non-profit advocacy organization that advances and protects the rights of Californians with disabilities, **supports SB 1026**. This bill is scheduled for hearing in the Senate Appropriations Committee on May 14, 2018.

This bill proposes the Dignity at Home and Fall Prevention Act, a logical successor to existing law's recognition of the growing desire for people to age in place. SB 1026 goes a step further than intent, awareness, and even practical information by providing grants to also fund services and equipment. This is a smart, logical recognition that fall prevention requires more than awareness. Fall prevention helps people stay at home, where they want to live.
