**RE: SB 1108 (HERNANDEZ) as amended June 20, 2018– SUPPORT**

Dear Assembly Member Gonzalez Fletcher:

Disability Rights California (DRC), a non-profit advocacy organization that advances and protects the rights of Californians with disabilities, **supports SB 1108**. This bill will soon come before you for hearing in the Assembly Appropriations Committee.

There has been a sea-change in Washington, D.C. The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) shifted course by allowing states to introduce a work requirement as a condition for receiving Medicaid services. This bill preemptively rejects that idea. Most Medi-Cal beneficiaries who are able to work do so. Many beneficiaries are unable to work, and it could be because of a disability or other valid reason. This is an important bill.
