SB 1113 provides the important authorization for the Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission to engage workplace mental health experts, consumers, and public and private employers to create a voluntary standard for mental health in the workplace. This effort to encourage the private sector to foster mental health and psychological safety by crafting a standard will assist in approving the mental health of their workers.
