**RE: SB 910 (HERNANDEZ) – REQUEST FOR SIGNATURE**

Dear Governor Brown:

Disability Rights California (DRC), a non-profit advocacy organization that advances and protects the rights of Californians with disabilities, **supports SB 910 and requests your signature.**

Short-term health insurance, sometimes called “junk insurance,” may seem appealing at first but this type of coverage disrupts the health insurance market and may deceive the purchaser who later finds out a particular condition is not covered.

Junk insurance takes us back to the days of underwriting, denials, limited benefits and discrimination against people with pre-existing conditions. We need to stick with the basic benefit guarantees we have come to expect. We also need to maintain a stable risk pool in order for the insurance market to work. Otherwise, as people leave the marketplace for something they think is better, everyone else faces the potential of significantly higher premiums.

For these reasons, DRC supports this bill and requests your signature. Please contact me if you have any questions about our position or if I can provide any further information.
